The Exhibition will include 23 arpilleras (textiles) and aims to stimulate awareness and conversations in relation to human rights violations in war-torn and post-conflict societies.

As part of the **ESRC Festival of Social Sciences** secondary school students in the North West have the unique opportunity to take part in a **Workshop**, arranged by Ulster University and Conflict Textiles. It will explore how textiles facilitate the narration of stories in conflict and human rights abuses. Students will also have the opportunity to take part in a guided tour of the international exhibition and view a related short film, Common Threads.
