Installation and unveiling of John and Pat Hume Commemorative Textiles

These commemorative textiles <u>John Hume</u>, <u>Peacemaker</u> and <u>Pat Hume</u> were recently unveiled at <u>Magee campus Library</u>, <u>Ulster University</u>, a campus where John and Pat had a strong presence over the years. Both textiles, together with related memorabilia donated by the Hume family are on display until 28th July 2022, as part of <u>Conflict Textiles collection</u>: <u>Magee campus Library</u>, <u>Ulster University</u> permanent rotating exhibition.

The installation is complemented by a selection of Hume materials from the Magee Library archives displayed on the ground floor. These include political leaflets, documents from the Derry Credit Union (of which John Hume was a key founding member) and a hand written letter from a child in 1993 pleading for peace.






