The textile was created as part of 'The Workhouse Through the Times' project funded by the National Lottery Heritage Fund, which aims to provide additional engagement in, and awareness of, the Limavady Workhouse. During September 2021, the women of Limavady Hen Shed participated in workshops to create small textiles pieces which reflect how the former Limavady Workhouse is used by the community in the 21st century. These small pieces were then brought together by artist Deborah Stockdale (Conflict Textiles) to create the final textile which be displayed in the foyer of LCDI (the former Workhouse Building).
