Dear Editor

We would like to invite your readers' to participate in an initial Day of Private Reflection being held on 21 June 2007.

The Day of Private Reflection is an initiative of Healing Through

Remembering, a cross-community organisation focusing on ways of dealing

with the past relating to the conflict in and about Northern Ireland, with the

aim of ensuring a peaceful and stable future for all.

The Day of Private Reflection is offered as an inclusive and positive experience that emphasises a commitment to a peaceful new society. It is an opportunity for people to acknowledge the deep hurt and pain caused by the conflict while also making a commitment that such loss should never be allowed to happen again.

The Day of Private Reflection has already received support from a wide range of organisations including community groups, churches and businesses, and from a wide range of individuals.

While the Day is a society-wide initiative, private is the key word and participation is entirely voluntary. It is an opportunity for people to reflect either individually on their own or within a family, a group or an organisation.

No specific public or civic events are being planned, but groups can be involved by raising awareness among their members, by making a place available where reflection can take place and/or by facilitating reflection.
