## Families of the Disappeared hold Stormont ceremony

Ceremony at Stormont Families of the Disappeared have held a ceremony at Stormont in Northern Ireland to remember those abducted by terrorists whose bodies have not yet been recovered.

Today was chosen for the commemoration because it is All Souls` Day when the dead are traditionally remembered.

Father Aidan Troy led a short prayer before the group walked to Parliament buildings.

A wreath was laid on the steps of Parliament Buildings by the widow of Charlie Armstrong who disappeared in 1981.

The families say today's event helps keep the unresolved issue in people's minds.
