## **"Name and shame duplicitous politicians" - Allister**

Statement from Jim Allister TUV MEP:-

"The allegation from Jarlath Burns of the Eames/Bradley Commission that prominent Unionist politicians, who have publicly protested about the contents of the report, were supportive in private, is disturbing and a further blow to the morale of the innocent victims.
