CLARKE CONDEMNS CAMPAIGN BY REPUBLICAN HYPOCRITES

South Antrim DUP MLA Trevor Clarke has condemned the sickening hypocrisy of Sinn Fein and their continuing attempts to write their own version of the republican movement's vicious campaign of the last forty years. He said today:

"Unionists will continue to fight to ensure history reflects the 'real truth' about what happened in Northern Ireland. The real truth is that the IRA embarked upon a bloody, butcherous campaign of murderous terrorism to drive unionists into a united Ireland. They failed in that goal and they will fail in any attempt to deflect the blame for what they did onto anyone else.

They harp on about collusion but when are they going to tell the truth about what they did at Teebane, at Enniskillen or on Bloody Friday? I lost a brother-in-law at Teebane so I have personal experience of how sickening it is for the relatives of people who have died at the hands of republicans to have to listen to them bleating on about how they are victims too.

In most cases, the people they are speaking about are not victims at all but actually terrorists who were either caught in the act or stopped before they embarked on another murderous venture. The terrorists killed at Loughall in 1987 in an SAS

operation is a case in point. They were there to bomb a police station or as they say 'an act of war'- a war where they were quite content to kill as many people as they could- but as soon as the terrorists are killed, all we get are hypocritical demands for inquiries and international intervention."

Mr Clarke stressed that unionists would never accept any attempt to equate members of the security forces with IRA terrorists:

"The UDR, the other regiments, and the RUC were there to defend all of the community from their bloodthirsty attempts to bomb and shoot us into a united Ireland. They were just doing a job like the men coming home from their work at Teebane. They are the true victims and the DUP will resist any attempt by republicans to re-write history."
