Sinn Féin representatives to support New Lodge families campaign

Sinn Féin representatives from North Belfast, including the party's Justice spokesperson Gerry Kelly, will tomorrow attend a Press Conference organised by the families of the New Lodge Six in the Ashton Centre, Churchill Street, Belfast at 10.15am.

The Press Conference is being organised by the families in the wake of weekend newspaper revelations that a former UVF member has publicly confirmed that he worked with British military intelligence to organise and take part in the 1973 gun attack which left six men dead.

The families are calling for the British government to break their silence into the New Lodge Six Massacre and will call for a fresh investigation into the circumstances surrounding the killings.
