Workshop Tkanine sukoba/Conflict Textiles

10am - 12 noon, 17th April 2019

Galerija Principij, Ulica pod Voltun 4, Rijeka

Introduction

This workshop was the fruit of collaboration between four agencies:

- Documenta Center for dealing with the past;
- EPK Rijeka 2020
- Galerija Principij Rijeka
- Stiftung "Erinnerung, Verantwortung und Zukunft" (EVZ)

It was led by Roberta Bacic and built on a long standing connection between her and Documenta.

Workshop focus

The workshop was a first step in laying the foundations for an exhibition that will take place in Rijeka in September 2019. Curators from Rijeka museum, volunteers from *Documenta* and other public sector organisations comprised the attendees.

Structure of workshop

Initially, Roberta Bacic introduced participants to the Conflict Textiles collection and to *arpilleras* in particular. She then gave an in-depth insight to <u>Homenaje a los caídos / Homage to the fallen ones</u>, an arpillera made in Chile in the 1970s. Following this overview, participants were invited to create a small doll that linked to the arpillera.

Outcome

At the end of the workshop participants had a good understanding of the Conflict Textiles collection. Seeing an *arpillera* first hand and engaging with it through the doll making process, helped them develop an appreciation of the origins and significance of arpilleras. In addition, valuable connections were made, which will be strengthened in the coming months as plans are developed for the exhibition in September 2019.
