Students are invited to visit this powerful art exhibition featuring portraits of 20 children who have died as a result of recent worldwide wars and conflicts and to learn more about the devastating impact of war on children.

These workshops build on connections developed with Letterkenny Amnesty Group since 2008 and more recently with 'Naming the Children' project through the 'War-Torn Children' exhibition in 2018.
