

List of Requirements for sewing Arpillera Dolls

Variety of small fabric scraps of different weight and textures, 4-5 pieces (approx. 10-15 cm each)

Two (2) pieces of tights, or two pieces of flesh coloured felt, also 10-15 cm square each

Small ball of cotton or scrap of tights material (for the head)

Sewing needle, and larger needle for yarn, and a few straight pins

Threads

Scissors

Coloured yarn or embroidery thread for hair...(ie,.black, brown, red, blond/yellow, grey). Around 1 or 1.5 m. in length

Optional: decorative trims, ribbons, small buttons

A label to write the identifying name. Remember, it does not need to be the name of the person who makes the doll, only the name given to the doll, although the maker can be included if they prefer. Please make sure it is firmly pinned onto the doll.

Self addressed and stamped envelope (to Roberta).

Print out of doll making images and completed doll images. These could be done in an A5 format.

Suggest that that items for making the dolls are pre-cut and put in ziplock sandwich bags, including the images for making the dolls, a label for when it is finished and the envelope for return.

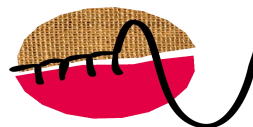
