To mark the 10th annual International Day of the Victims of Enforced Disappearances 30 August a new textile display is being installed in the *Troubles and Beyond* exhibition at the Ulster Museum in Belfast.

Seven pieces from the Conflict Textiles collection have been selected to explore transnational experiences of enforced disappearances. Textiles from Chile, Argentina Zimbabwe, and Northern Ireland will be presented together as testimonies from families and communities who have experienced loss and continue to search for answers.
