In the latest installment of the rotating exhibition “The Troubles and Beyond”, Conflict Textiles has included 2 pieces, one by Irene MacWilliam and a portrait of her by Helen Perry.

Irene’s piece, Peace Quilt - Common Loss, is a quilt made of 3000+ scraps of red cloth, each representing someone who died as part of the Troubles.

Helen’s piece was commissioned by Conflict Textiles and provides us with an insight into the core issues that Irene has depicted over the years.
