
## CONFLICT TEXTILES

**2nd Station**: **Ellie Ferguson**, student at UU in the School of Arts had an actual loom and showed us how she uses it and also referred to her studies and her interest in connecting the weaving to fashion. She also had samples of her work and referred to other specific connections and projects.
