The IPOD* Young Women's Project, funded by The Big Lottery is an innovative and dynamic project that runs from the Women Centre four times per week.

"A piece of me, a piece of us" quilt was crafted in the emotional health programme and made in conjunction with Eden Place Arts Centre. The quilt was inspired by "The politics of Chilean Arpilleras" exhibition held at the Harbor Museum April 2008.

The quilt consists of seven individual "arpilleras", five of which were created by the participants of the project and the additional two were completed by the IPOD project coordinator and the community art facilitator.

The group met over a 10 week period. Stories were shared and peer support was offered. Each piece offers a window into the life of the young woman who made it and gives an insight into what is important to each of them on a daily basis.
