STATEMENT BY MR R CHICHESTER-CLARK M P ON DR HILLERY FRIDAY JULO 10L110 AM

DR HILLERY, THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS IN THE REPUBLIC OF IRELAND, HAS BEEN ENGAGED IN STRENUOUS "DIPLOMATIC" ACTIVITIES DURING THE LAST FEW DAYS. HE HAS REPEATEDLY STATED THAT HIS OBJECTIVE IS TO REDUCE FEARS AND TENSION IN NORTHERN IRELAND. HE HAS ALSO SAID THAT A MAJOR CONTRIBUTION TO THIS END WOULD BE THE CANCELLATION OF THE ORANGE PARADES ON JULY 13.

HE IS, OF COURSE, ASKING THE ORANGEMEN TO ABANDON THE CIVIL RIGHT HPON WHICH THEY PLACE THE GREATEST VALUE AT THE PRESENT TIME AND WHICH THEY HAVE ENJOYED, ALMOST INVARIABLY PEACEFULLY, FOR GENERATIONS. THE FEARS AND TENSIONS OF NORTHERN IRELAND TODAY DO NOT EXIST JUST IN ONE PART OF THE COMMUNITY. THE APPREHENSIONS OF THE MAJORITY OF ABSORPTION INTO THE IRISH REPUBLIC IS NOWADAYS OFTEN FORGOTTEN. DR HILLERY COULD MAKE A GESTURE AT THIS CRITICAL TIME WHICH WOULD CONTRIBUTE SUBSTANTIALLY TO I XX HIS PROFESSED. DESIRE FOR A PEACEFUL AND HARMONIOUS CLIMATE IN THE PROVINCE. I. THEREFORE, CHALLENGE HIM TO OFFER TO THE ORANGE ORDER IN RETURN FOR THE SACRIFICE WHICH HE ASKS OF THEM, FULL RECOGNITION OF NORTHERN IRELAND AS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE UNITED KINGDOM INSTEAD OF CLAIMING TERRITORIAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE WHOLE OF IRELAND AS THE REPUBLIC INSISTENTLY DOES IN ITS PRESENT CONSTITUTION. THIS WOULD BE TRUE STATEMANSHIP AND A REAB CONTRIBUTION TO THE IMPROVEMENT OF RELATIONS BETWEEN THE COMMUNITIES.

I AM ARRANGING TO HAVE ACOPY OF THIS STATEMENT DELIVERED TO DR HILLERY THGOUGH THE EMBASSY OF THE IRISH REPUBLIC AS A MATTER OF URGENCY.
