

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

NORTHERN IRELAND (EMERGENCY PROVISIONS) ACT 1973

I, THE RIGHT HONOURABLE MERLYN REES MP, One of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by the Northern Ireland (Emergency Provisions) Act 1973 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1973") and of all other powers enabling me in this behalf, HEREBY AUTHORISE ROBERT HUNTER DAVIS, Defence Land Agent, Property Services Agency, 25 Windsor Park, Belfast, or any person for the time being holding the office of such Agent, to take possession of a parcel of land measuring approximately at its sides 45 metres, 65 metres, 25 metres, 45 metres, 20 metres and 20 metres being part of the football ground or land appurtenant thereto at the corner of that ground nearest to the Royal Ulster Constabulary Station at Crossmaglen in the County of Armagh and which parcel is more particularly delineated and described in the map attached hereto (including any wall or fence on or near such land and any property thereon) for occupation by Her Majesty's Forces and to do or cause to be done any act on or in relation to the said land or property as is specified in Section 17(2) of the Act of 1973.
