- 95. That Congress instruct the Management Committee of the G.A.A. to appoint a small sub-committee to work earnestly to obtain the return of all G.A.A. property in Crossmaglen. That this Committee be instructed to use all the resources of the G.A.A. at home and abroad to achieve the following aims:
- (a) The return of all G.A.A. property in Crossmaglen to its rightful owners.
- (b) A guarantee from the British Government that no further destruction of the G.A.A. property will take place in the future and that intimidation and obstruction of the G.A.A. officials, players and supporters will cease immediately.
- (c) Satisfactory compensation is obtained from the British

 Government for all destruction and occupation of the G.A.A.
