You enquired back in June whether we knew anything about reports which Senator Kennedy's office had heard to the effect that Britain had recently purchased helicopter gunships. The Senator's office wanted to know if there was any question of their being used in Northern Ireland.

The Embassy at London made informal enquiries of the FCO and have now been told that the British Ministry of Defence is buying chinook helicopters from the United States. The FCO added that there could not at all be regarded as helicopter gunships, but are large load-carrying helicopters intended for moving stores and equipment and sometimes passengers. They said that there is no present intention of using them in Northern Ireland.
