Sir,

On behalf of a long suffering loyalist community we protest most strongly about lack of security. The Ulster Unionist Councillors' meeting in Dungannon last night decided to continue in protest against the lack of security. The following resolution was passed:-

"That Unionist Councillors seek to adjourn meetings of their Councils and committees with the exception of transacting financial business relating to staff, and those conducting trade with the Council. This action to be taken as a means of highlighting the alienation of the British citizens in Ulster over the absence of adequate security precautions and as a protest over the Anglo/Irish Council."

The councillors decided to implement the strategy on security and steps are now being taken to carry this out.
