NOTICE TO ADMIT FACTS

TAKE NOTICE that the Petitioners in this cause require the Respondent to admit, for the purposes of this cause only, the several facts respectively hereunder specified; and the Respondent is hereby required, within six days from the service of this Notice, to admit the said several facts, saving all just exceptions to the admissibility of such facts as evidence in this cause.

The facts, the admissions of which is required, are:-

1. That the Respondent was nominated by the Prime Minister of the Republic of Ireland under section 3 of Article 18 of the Constitution of the Republic of Ireland to be a member of the Senate of the Parliament of the Republic of Ireland.
2. That the Clerk to the Senate on the 13th day of May 1982 read out to the Senate the names of those nominated and elected to the Senate, and that the Respondent's name was one of the names read out by the Clerk.
3. That the Respondent has taken his seat in the Senate, and has participated and voted in debates in the Senate.

That at all material times the Respondent has remained a member of the Senate of the Parliament of the Republic of Ireland.

5. That the Respondent was a candidate in the elections for the Northern Ireland Assembly held on the 20th day of October 1982.


6. That the Returning Officer returned the Respondent to the Clerk of the Assembly on the 25th day of October 1982 as one of the members elected for Armagh.

7. That the Senate of which the Respondent is a member is part of the legislature of the Republic of Ireland.

8. That the Republic of Ireland is not part of the Commonwealth.
