> The Department of Foreign Affairs strongly recommend that the Taoiseach meet the delegation from the AFL-CIO. Our Washington Embassy have been developing contacts with the organisation and the Ambassador has met Tom Donahue, Secretary Treasurer of the organisation. There is also a proposal under consideration for the attendance by an Irish Trade Union Official, as an observer, at the next Annual conference of AFL-CIO which is due to be held in Florida later this year. I am getting some further briefing from Foreign Affairs on these matters.

I attach, as requested, a report on the meeting which the then Taoiseach had with Irish/American Trade Union Leaders in New York in June, 1982,together with a list of those present. Mr. Donahue was not among them.
