Statement of Speaker Thomas P. O'Neill, Jr. November 15, 1985

THANK YOU MR. PRESIDENT FOR INVITING ME TO JOIN YOU IN EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE HISTORIC ANGLO-IRISH AGREEMENT REACHED TODAY. I AM DELIGHTED TO BE HERE.

I CONGRATULATE THE LEADERS OF THE GOVERNMENTS OF IRELAND AND GREAT BRITAIN FOR TAKING THIS IMPORTANT AND COURAGEOUS STEP OF CCN3TRUCTING A FRAMEWORK FOR PEACE AND RECONCILIATION IN NORTHERN IRELAND.

THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE AGREEMENT TODAY DEMONSTRATES IN UNMISTAKABLE FASHION THAT THE WAY FORWARD IN NORTHERN IRELAND IS NOT THROUGH THE BULLET AND THE BOMB BUT RATHER THROUGH DIRECT NEGOTIATIONS BETWEEN THE FREELY ELECTED LEADERS OF TWO GREAT WESTERN DEMOCRACIES.

I AM HOPEFUL THAT THIS AGREEMENT WILL PROVIDE THE BASIS FOR BUILDING A BRIDGE OF HOPE AND RECONCILIATION BETWEEN THE BASIS FOR GREAT TRADITIONS IN NORTHERN IRELAND. WE KNOW FROM OUR EXPERIENCE IN AMERICA THAT DIVERSITY CAN BE A SOURCE OF STRENGTH IN A SOCIETY RATHER THAN A SOURCE OF DIVISION.

BEGINNING TODAY MUCH MUST BE DONE TO BUILD A LASTING PEACE IN NORTHERN IRELAND. BÉCAUSE OF THIS, I AM PLEASED TO HEAR THE PRESIDENT REAFFIRM THE COMMITMENT OF THE UNITED STATES TO HEAR THE PROMOTE PEACE AND RECONCILIATION IN NORTHERN IRELAND IN A

I CAN ASSURE THE PRESIDENT THAT AS SPEAKER I WILL DO EVERYTHING IN MY POWER TO SEE THAT SUCH A COMMITMENT, INCLUDING APPF.OPRIATE FINANCIAL AND ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE, IS HONORED BY THE CONGRESS AS SWIFTLY AND AS FULLY AS POSSIBLE. I AM SURE THAT MY MICHEL, TOM FOLEY AND JOE MCDADE WILL JOIN WITH ME AND THE MANY FRIENDS OF IRELAND ON CAPITOL HILL TO HELP MAKE THIS IMPORTANT AMERICAN CONTRIBUTION TO PEACE, JUSTICE AND RECONCILIATION IN
