MINISTER GIVES DETAILS OF RISE IN PUNISHMENT ATTACKS

In reply today to a written Question from Mr John Hume MP (Foyle) the Rt Hon John Stanley MP, Minister of State at the Northern Ireland Office, gave the following statistics regarding punishment attacks in the Province.
