16.30 Arrive Dublin Airport from Áras an Uachtaráin

16.45 Depart Dublin Airport for Liverpool's Speke Airport

17.20 Arrive Speke airport

Greeted on arrival by the Lord Lieutenant of Cheshire, Mr. William Bromley Davenport, Ambassador Small and Mrs. Small

Transfer to motorcade

Car 1 - President, Mr. Robinson, SDU and Liaison Protection Officer Bahra

Car 2 - Ambassador, Mrs. Small, Ms. Rosney and Helena Nolan

17.50 Arrive Warrington Town Hall

Greeted at the entrance by the Mayor of Warrington, Councillor John Pennington and the Mayoress, Mrs. Pennington, the Chairman of the Council, Councillor Pat Tyrell and Mrs. Tyrell, the Chief Executive of the Council, Mr. Mike Saunders and Mrs. Saunders

The President is escorted to the foyer where she is introduced to the Deputy Mayor, Councillor John Taylor and Mrs. Taylor, Mr. Mike Hall M.P. (Labour Party) and Mr. Doug Hoyle M.P. (Labour Party)

[Both of the deceased children were from Mr. Hall's constituency. The bombing occurred in Mr. Hoyle's constituency]

Notes: Mr. John Smith M.P., Leader of the Labour Party, will be in the Town Hall at this time and may also be in the foyer

No media presence inside the Town Hall although official Council photographer will be present

The President and Mr. Robinson, escorted by the Mayor and Deputy Mayor, proceed to the Mayor's Parlour where they have a brief meeting (5 minutes approx)

18.00 The Mayor greets the Duke of Edinburgh at the entrance of the Town Hall

The Duke of Edinburgh is escorted to the Mayor's Parlour by the Mayor and is introduced to the President and Mr. Robinson

After a brief conversation the President and Mr. Robinson are escorted to a private room where they meet with representatives of the Warrington Irish Association (Chairman, Secretary, Dr. Paddy O'Brien and Dr. Walter Burke)

Opportunity to freshen up

[18.05 Mayor and main civic party depart for St. Elphin's Parish Church]

18.15

President and Irish party depart for St. Elphin's Parish Church (security escort will determine exact departure time)

[18.20 Duke of Edinburgh departs Town Hall for Church]

18.20 Arrive at St. Ehphin's Parish Church

President and party escorted to their designated seats

18.30 Service commences

19.45 Service expected to conclude

President, Mr. Robinson, the Duke of Edinburgh and the Prime Minister meet privately with the Ball and Parry families in the Rectory which is adjacent to the Church. The Parry childrens' names are Abigail and Dominic. Also present are the Mayor and Mayoress and the Rector, Canon John Colling. No Media are present.

20.00 Duke of Edinburgh departs for airport

20.10 President and party depart for Liverpool airport.
