The President-Elect was very friendly and warm in his greeting. He mentioned that he had been on a visit to Ireland - presumably during his period as a student in Oxford between 1968 to 1970. I conveyed greetings from Dublin, to which the President-Elect replied that he was looking forward to working with the Government and, of course, to the St. Patrick's Day period.
