The Director of Public Prosecutions has today informed the British Crown Prosecution Service of his decision in the case of Patrick Ryan. He has given careful consideration to the material furnished by the Crown Prosecution Service. This consisted of material which was received by the Director in January and further material which was subsequently made available in July, 1989.

The Garda Siochana, at the request of the Director, made certain further enquiries in the matter.

The Director's consideration of the matter, in the course of which he had the benefit of the assistance of his officers and of officers of the Garda Siochana, was directed to the question whether the material which has been made available is sufficient to justify the initiation of a prosecution against Patrick Ryan. He has come to the clear conclusion that it is not sufficient for that purpose, and accordingly that a prosecution would not be justified.
