



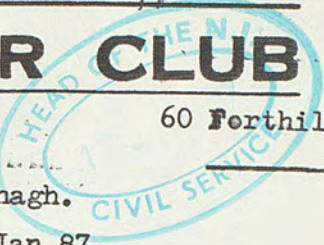

MAY ALL OUR ENEMIES SO PERISH.

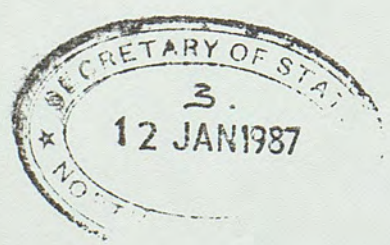
