I am writing to follow up on your conversation with the Prime Minister about organising an Elton John concert in the Stormont Parklands in Belfast. I was delighted to learn that you are keen to pursue the idea because, as Tony explained, such an event would be an enormous boost to confidence at a critical time for us in Northern Ireland.

I have now spoken to Jim Aiken with whom you have also been in touch and talked through some of the practical issues which need to be addressed to make this exciting and important event happen.

We think that an Elton John Concert during the first week of July held in the Stormont Parklands would be a winning combination for all of us in Northern Ireland. Jim thinks we should aim for a crowd of about 10,000 to 12,000 on a site just in front of Parliament Buildings and I attach some photographs to give you an idea of the location.

In order, however, to take the project forward you need to let me know the financial arrangements for securing Elton. Elton's fee is a key consideration, and whether, for example, the amount of the fee, or whether it might be waived, donated to charity or used in part to support a children's playground in the Stormont Parklands. The Playground could then be dedicated to Elton.
