**LOBBYING PAYMENTS: DOYLE AND NELSON
AUGUSTA, MAINE.**

I attach Doyle and Nelsons bill for lobbying activity in Augusta, up to the end of January 1990, and would be grateful if payment could be made direct as soon as possible and preferably before the Macbride hearing on 5th March. You will note that this latest bill takes them close to the ceiling of \$7500, and work done so far in February means that the limit has already been reached.

Our lobbyists appear to be working hard on our behalf and, after a call on them on 14th February, Andy Henderson and I were satisfied that they fully understood HMG's position and what we hoped to achieve and would continue to fairly present our case to the Maine Senators and Representatives involved in the Committees hearing the bill and to others who may be able to influence the outcome.

In the circumstances I recommend that we should continue to employ Doyle and Nelson and would be grateful for your authorisation by return to do so.

Whether you wish to impose a further ceiling of say \$7500 with a review after the hearing on 5th March, or some other arrangement, I will leave to you and Pat McAlister to decide.
