## "LIVING WITH THE TRAUMA OF THE TROUBLES" - CUNAMH

You wrote to Kevin McCoy on 8 July and attached a copy of a request from Cunamh for funding to provide support for people providing evidence to the Saville Inquiry.

Given that Cunamh represents people who are victims of civil unrest it may have access to funding which is available to victims' groups. We understand there are a number of sources which the organisation might be advised to approach such as the Community Relations Council for Northern Ireland Voluntary Trust. Another possible source of assistance might be the Saville Inquiry itself. As you can see from the enclosed, I have already referred your letter and the Cunamh proposal to the Inquiry.

As a local project it does not of course meet the Department's criteria for funding. Departmental funding can be considered only where a project is a regional one, or is a local one with potential regional significance which the relevant Board or Trust supports but is unable to fund. Your letter does not make clear whether or not the project has Board and Trust support following a full assessment of need for the service, or whether local funding is not available due to competing priorities.

I enclose a letter which this Department has recently received from the Western Health and Social Services Board about funding for a proposal by Cunamh, a locally based voluntary organisation, to provide support for people giving evidence to the Saville Inquiry.
