NI BUREAU - INFORMATION FLOWS

- 1. The provision of relevant briefing for this week's visit to Washington by the First Minister and Deputy First Minister has highlighted the need for all of us to be conscious of the information requirements of the NI Bureau. In order for the Bureau to maintain credibility with US contacts in carrying out it's key functions, and as it develops a pro-active role in promoting the work of the NI Executive, it needs to be kept informed of significant developments here.
- 2. The Bureau makes every effort to keep up-to-date through a variety of sources. However, the pace of development in some areas can be such that these arrangements are not always sufficient, and may indeed be overlooked due to the pressures closer to home. Key areas such as the developing
