PEACE II MEASURE 4.1 – MEASURE SPECIFIC CRITERIA

Applications will be scored on the extent to which a project:-

- (1) Encourages a more constructive dialogue with other EU regions on economic, social and environmental matters;
- (2) promotes abroad the positive image of a more peaceful society; and
- (3) contributes to making Northern Ireland and the Border Region a more outward and forward looking region by:
 - (a) developing networks of co-operation within Northern Ireland and the Border Region, and/or between Northern Ireland and the Border Region and Europe or other international regions;
 - (b) encouraging a structured approach to participation in wider European and international networks; and
 - (c) enabling exchange of best practice with European or other international networks in areas such as economic development and conflict resolution.
