Doar Brothers in Christ:

I write this letter in deep distress and disillisionment. I draw your attention to the publication of the Office of International Justice and Peace/U.S. Catholic Conference, "Northern Ireland: A Religious Conflict."

On page 12 of this publication, the Irish National Caucus is described as "an American-mased support group for the I.R.A. Provisionals."

As leader and spokesman for the Irish National Caucus, I wish to formally protest such an irresponsible statement - the seriousness and accountability of which is in no may diminished simply because it is a quotation.

The Irish National Caucus has no foreign principal as can be verified with Mr. Brian Ahcarn of the U.S. Department of Justice (Foreign Agent Registration Act). It, therefore, does not morally or firencially support any group or organization in Ireland, and it is not "an American support group for the I.R.A. Provisionals."

I onclose a copy of our official Position Paper. You will see there that the Irish National Caucus is clearly and unequivocally a non-violent organization.

Journalistic ethics - not to mention justice and nonce - should have demnded that the Office of International Justice & Peace give the Irish National Caucus the courtesy of a call before it made reference to the Caucus. Surely we were entitled to at least that? (Our Secretary/Treasurer, Ms. Bernadette O'Roilly of Washington, D.C., had, well in advance of publication, been in contact with Mr. Edward Doherty of the Office of International Justice & Peace. Why did he not simply ask her if the Irish National Caucus was a support group for the I.R.A.?)

This morally unjust and journalistically inexcusable action has caused the Irich National Caucus untold harm; it will, also, in the minds of many, bring the Office of Intermational Justice & Poace into serious disrepute. In light of the facts, how can they - who expected the Office to be the beacon of justice and peace - avoid cynicism, not only about that Office, but also the Church?

Now that you know that the Irish National Caucus is not a support group for the I.R.A., will the Office of International Justice & Poace make restitution by pub-

lishing a retraction? Surely it is only under British Rule in Northern Ireland that a person is guilty until proven innocent?

I urgently request that a retraction be published. I make this request respect-fully and non-agressively. Please undo the harm and pain that have been caused.
