HONOURS - DIVERSITY SEMINAR

Thank you for your minute of 11 September 2003. I am pleased you will be attending this seminar and shall provide ODPM colleagues with details.

I note the points you raised about statistical information: as a matter of policy we do not specifically collect information about the ethnicity of individuals other than nationality which is required. In the context of public nominations, we rely on 3rd party information from the nominator and ethnicity, if not overtly referred to, may be guessed at from the information provided. Information on gender and publicly supported nominations is available.

Given the purpose of the seminar - to determine ways of identifying more potential candidates from specific groups - then more relevant information is likely to be the numbers in those groups. I am not however concerned that individual Departments will be expected to have figures available nor to discuss them: we will not be put in a defensive position and I am content to field questions that might arise concerning public nominations and gender balance of Awards.

Happy to discuss as required in advance of the seminar.

HONOURS DIVERSITY SEMINAR

Thank you for your minute of 3 September 2003 to Mary Bunting on the above subject. Mary has asked me to pursue this further.

As we discussed in the smoking room, I will be happy to attend the meeting as the OFMDFM "diversity expert" (my colleagues on the gender policy side are otherwise engaged on that day).

I think that it would be enormously useful if we could go armed with some sort of breakdown of figures for NI relating to nominations for, and award of, honours according to gender and race. I understand from our conversation that you may have some figures (although not complete). We really do need to set the record for awards to minority ethnic people in NI in the context of the relatively small population here. Minority ethnic people may not necessarily be underrepresented here (although I daresay that women are).

Although we probably do not need to do this specifically for the meeting, we also need to consider how we might go about ethnic and gender monitoring of the honours process. (I understand that this is not already done as a matter of course). The meeting may, in fact, provide some useful ideas on this.
