Users can search for information on:

- key events and issues;
- chronologies, bibliographies, and databases;
- abstracts about organisations, and biographies of people.

Collections of photographs and ephemeral material are also available, or you can walk on 'Memorial Road' in a virtual world.

Recent additions include a digital archive on Remembering: Victims, Survivors and Commemoration and related material on Visualising the Conflict containing GIS maps, interactive Google maps and a virtual educational space.
