*My dear Garner,*

I wish to thank you for your letter of the 25th March from which I note with pleasure that the Board of Trustees of the Imperial War Museum have agreed to hand over to the Irish authorities the flag which flew over the General Post Office in Dublin during the Easter Rising in 1916. As I have already informed you, I am quite agreeable to your suggestion to have a small presentation ceremony in your office at 4.30 p.m. on the 30th March.
