Association Chairman, Cllr. Trevor Wilson said:

"While the UUP will issue a formal response once we have sight of the report we would like to highlight our deep dismay at the proposals which have been leaked. This report has re-victimised those who have suffered loss at the hands of terrorists and if the report is accepted it will legitimise the terror campaign. Northern Ireland has not emerged from thirty years of terrorism to be persuaded by The Rt Rev Eames and Mr Denis Bradley that terrorists were justified.

"This attempt to create some sort of parity between the terrorists who carried out brutal and criminal actions, and the members of the security forces and entirely innocent civilians who were murdered by those terrorists, will strike many people as both repugnant and immoral."
